

## April 7, 2022 (day 43)

Yesterday, April 6, in Vuhledar, **Donetsk region**, the number of victims as a result of the shelling of the place of distribution of humanitarian aid increased to 4 people.

In **Mariupol**, one of the buildings of the city hospital was destroyed, where 50 people were burned alive.

In **Bucha, Kyiv region**, 112 private houses were destroyed and hundreds damaged. 18 apartment buildings were severely damaged and burned down. Three places of mass burial have already been found in the city. In **Borodyanka**, the bodies of those killed in the ruins of apartment buildings were found, where civilians were present during the air strikes. 200 people are missing in Borodyanka, the city is considered one of the most destroyed. 400 civilians are known to have died in the **Kyiv region**.

Patients were forcibly taken from the №4 hospital in **Mariupol** to Russia and the temporarily occupied Donbass. The mayor reports that a total of at least 40,000 residents were forcibly removed from the city. In addition, more than 100 children have already been deported to occupied Donetsk and Taganrog.

Three people were killed in night artillery shelling in **Kharkiv region**. In total, 48 artillery and mortar strikes were inflicted on Kharkiv's civilian infrastructure during the night.

The shelling of Rubizhne and Popasna **Luhansk region** remains intense. There are no surviving hospitals in the region.

In the occupied **Crimea**, Crimean people are being recruited en masse to serve in the aggressor's armed forces.

**Austria** has sent four Russian diplomats.

The **UN General Assembly** voted to suspend Russia's work in the UN Human Rights Council due to systematic human rights violations by the Russian military.
