The Armed Forces of Ukraine continue to liberate settlements in Chernihiv, Kyiv (Bucha, Borodyanka and Gostomel liberated) and Kherson (11 settlements) oblasts.

Ivankivska, Dymerska and Poliska communities remain in a difficult situation in **Kyiv region**. They are on the verge of a humanitarian catastrophe, as they have been temporarily under enemy control since the first days of the confrontation. For a week now, rescuers have been dismantling blockages in food warehouses near Kyiv. Four people were killed during the storming of checkpoints near **Slavutych**. The occupiers were in the city for less than a day, so no significant damage was done, but there are suspicions that mines were left in the surrounding forest.

Over the past 24hrs, **Kharkiv** has been shelled 170 times by Grad. There were also 46 artillery, mortar and tank shellings in the city. The situation in the city of **Izium** remains difficult. 20,000 residents of this city need to be evacuated, but no agreement can be reached on "green corridors" within 20 days.

Yesterday, a column of volunteers from five buses trying to evacuate the surrounding city to evacuate people was shot dead near **Chernihiv** (one person was killed and four were seriously injured). The cars were completely destroyed.

It is reported that the occupiers left the territory of the **Chernobyl** nuclear power plant, but took hostage members of the National Guard of Ukraine, who guarded the facility until February 24. It is also noted that the Russian military stole computers, household appliances and utensils from the station.

A recently renovated modern hospital was shot down with mortars and tanks in **Trostryanets**, Sumy Oblast.

In the **Kherson region**, the occupiers are trying to consolidate their power and have appointed several collaborators to manage the captured Kakhovka.

In the **Donetsk region**, 7 civilians were killed and 22 were injured in the last 24 hours. According to the Ukrainian side, the Russian occupiers forcibly deported 45,000 city residents from **Mariupol** to the territory of the Russian Federation and the territory of the so-called DPR. The Russian military is trying to establish full control over the city of Mariupol.

Today there were 9 humanitarian corridors for evacuation, including from Mariupol, Melitopol and Berdyansk.
